Facilitators, Coaches, and Editors: Experts to support and guide school teams in discussions about their proposals. Facilitators and coaches will assist in communication management strategies among school stakeholders. Editors will support school teams in plan writing and the translation of ideas to paper.

Curriculum and Instruction: Experts to support school teams in discussions about innovative curricular strategies, equitable access to instruction, research-based curriculum, assessment of student needs, serving specialized populations, accelerated learning, etc.

School Culture and Climate: Experts to support school teams in discussions about positive academic and social environment, professional culture, college and career readiness, school calendar and schedule, athletic programs, discipline, healthcare, etc.

Assessment and School Data: Experts to support school teams in discussions about identifying educational goals and metrics, graduation rates, college acceptance rates, career readiness, student assessment plans, data systems, operational goals and metrics, etc.

Professional Development: Experts to support school teams in discussions about professional development planning, teacher orientation, program evaluation, etc.

School Leadership, Staffing, & Operations: Experts to support school teams in discussions about staffing models and student/teacher ratios, compensation, school leadership and administration, recruitment of staff, school operations, budget etc.
